

*CASTLE II JUMP BOUNCE HOUSE and
SLIDE N' SPLASH DRY/WET SLIDE
PROCEDURE*

*I. TO RESERVE THE "CASTLE II JUMP BOUNCE HOUSE" OR
THE "SLIDE N' SPLASH DRY/WET SLIDE"*

- A. The Unit(s) may only be reserved:
 - 1. For one (1) week at a time.
 - 2. Not more than three (3) months in advance.
 - 3. If reserved to be picked-up on Friday only the reserving church may use it that week-end.
 - a. Each Unit must be returned to the NSRBA Resource Center before another church may use it.
 - b. Each church must pick-up and return The Unit(s) to the NSRBA Resource Center.
- B. The Units may be reserved together or separately.
- C. The Unit(s) may only be checked out by:
 - 1. A church, mission, or fellowship which is a participating member of the New South River Baptist Association.
 - 2. An organization within NSRBA (WMU, Brotherhood, Youth, etc.) may check out The Unit(s):
 - a. All requirements listed in "II" below must be followed.
 - b. THE CHURCH HOSTING THE EVENT MUST ACCEPTS ALL LIABILITY AND RESPONSIBILITIES AND PLACES A DEPOSIT.
 - 3. A Church Childcare Center or Daycare Center may NOT check out The Unit(s):
 - a. A NSRBA Church which operates a Childcare or Daycare Center may check out The Unit(s) to be used at the Childcare/Daycare Center which they operate.
 - b. All requirements listed in "II" below must be followed.
 - c. The Church (not the Childcare/Daycare Center) must accept all liability and responsibilities and place a deposit.
 - 4. The Unit(s) can not be checked out for Personal use.

*II. TO PICK-UP THE "CASTLE II JUMP BOUNCE HOUSE" OR
THE "SLIDE N' SPLASH DRY/WET SLIDE"*

- A. The Pastor, Full Time Staff Member, or Approved Person of the church checking out The Unit(s) will be given a copy of the NSRBA "Castle II Jump Bounce House and Slide N' Splash Dry/Wet Slide Procedure" and must acknowledge his reading, understanding and agreement with it.
- B. The Pastor or Full Time Staff Member or Approved Person of the church checking out The Unit(s) must sign "The Acknowledgement and Agreement with The NSRBA 'Castle II Jump Bounce House and Slide N' Splash Dry/Wet Slide Procedure'", the NSRBA the "Wavier of Liability" and the NSRBA "Responsibility for Damages" Statements each time The Unit(s) are checked out.
- C. If a church does not have a Pastor or Full Time Staff Member at the time of use the DOM will notify who from the church can sign the "Statements".
- D. The Pastor does not have to be present when The Unit(s) are picked-up he may come by and sign the "Acknowledgement and Agreement with Procedure", the "Wavier of Liability" and the "Responsibility for Damages" Statements no more than a week prior to the church picking up The Unit(s).
- E. Each Unit has a **\$50.00 deposit required** (\$100 if both Units are used) which must be paid before it is released.
 - 1. The deposit will be returned by mail when it is determined that no damage has occurred to The Unit(s) and The Unit(s) are in proper working order.
 - 2. This deposit must be paid each time a Unit is used.
 - 3. If the "Deposit" is paid by check please make it out to NSRBA.

- F. The persons who actually come to pick-up The Unit(s) must have adequate help and transportation.
 - 1. Please arrange for The Unit(s) to be transported in a pick-up truck or cargo van, no cars, SUV, or church vans (a trailer with a “loading gate” works very well)..
 - 2. Each Unit is very heavy and requires multiple people to move.
 - a. The “Castel II Jump Bounce House” comes in a bag (4’ high and 7’ round) strapped to a hand truck and weights approximately 200 lbs.
 - b. The “Slide N’ Splash Dry/Wet Slide” is laid flat and takes up an area of 4’ x 7’ and is moved on a flat cart, all together weighting approximately 400 lbs.
- G. It should be assumed that NO HELP WILL BE GIVEN FROM THE NSRBA STAFF IN LOADING OR UNLOADING THE UNIT(S).
- H. When The Unit(s) are picked up the following items are included
 - 1. The requested Unit(s).
 - 2. The attached hand truck or flat cart, which is used to move The Unit(s).
 - 3. Set-up Video, Instruction, and Safety Manuals.

III. CARE OF THE “CASTLE II JUMP BOUNCE HOUSE” OR THE “SLIDE N’ SPLASH DRY/WET SLIDE”

- A. While in possession of The Unit(s) the church is responsible to ensure that all means for proper safety and care is taken for both The Unit(s) and those who use The Unit(s).
- B. Before inflating please read all Instruction and Safety Manuals, and also it is encouraged that the “Set-up Video” is watched.
- C. All local city and county ordinances must be followed; it is the responsibility of each church to ensure that all “Government Permits” are obtained.
- D. All safety features for The Unit(s) are to be followed:
 - 1. The Unit(s) are to be properly secured to the ground.
 - 2. Appropriate “Fall Zones” are to be observed.
 - 3. No “rough play” is to be allowed.
 - 4. All “Rider Number” and “Weight” Limits are to be observed.
 - 5. Adult supervision is required at all times that The Unit(s) is in use.
- E. The Unit(s) should be set up on a grassy surface (no gravel or other such surfaces that they may puncher The Unit(s).
- F. The Unit(s) are NOT TO BE LEFT OUTSIDE OVERNIGHT.

IV. TO RETURN THE “CASTLE II JUMP BOUNCE HOUSE” OR THE “SLIDE N’ SPLASH DRY/WET SLIDE”

- A. The Unit(s) is to be returned before 12:00 noon on the day that it is due.
- B. Any damages or repairs made to The Unit(s) are to be reported.
- C. The Unit(s) must be in working order and all items that go with The Unit(s) must also be returned in order for the “Deposit” to be returned.
- D. It should be assumed that NO HELP WILL BE GIVEN FROM THE NSRBA STAFF IN UNLOADING THE UNIT(S) when they are returned.
